



Overview

The Level 4 Award in External Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practices qualification is designed to provide learners with the knowledge, skills and understanding of the principles and practices required to ensure and maintain the quality of assessment externally, usually on behalf of an Awarding Organisation.

The purpose of this qualification is to allow individuals to work in an external quality assurance role. The units specified within this document cover a variety of areas relevant to the sector, including, an understanding of the principles and practices of external quality assurance of assessment, and the practice of externally assuring the quality of assessment.

- Learners must have access to, be working with, or have permission to work with an Awarding Organisation to meet the requirements within Unit 2: Externally assure the quality of assessment.
